Registration

Convention Forms:

- Please read all instructions carefully. If you have questions, please ask your sponsor or get in touch with the regional chair (contact information below).
- Type or print neatly in blue or black ink when completing forms.
- Please use your official legal name on your form. If you wish for a nickname to be added to your nametag, please add it in parentheses after your first name.
- Students: be sure that your parent/guardian and sponsor have signed where their signatures are required.
- Students and chaperones: please return completed forms and payment to your sponsor, unless directed otherwise.
- **Registration forms and fees must be postmarked on or before Saturday, February 8, 2020.** Late registrations will be charged a late fee of \$15 and will only be accepted on a space-available basis. Please have your sponsor check with the chair before you submit a late registration.

Fees

- Please work carefully and read all instructions as you fill out the fee section on page 1 of the form. Mistakes in your fee calculation may result in delays in your registration.
- The cost of the convention for student delegates is \$180. We are pleased to offer chaperones and sponsors a reduced convention cost of \$155 in appreciation for your time and service. The convention cost includes lodging Friday and Saturday night of the convention, all meals from Friday dinner through Sunday lunch, a convention T-shirt, and access to all convention activities and events.
- Please ask your sponsor if your delegation is bringing its own bedding or renting linens. If your delegation is renting linens, please add \$12. Otherwise, leave the 'linen fee' line blank or write '0'.
- Page 3 has information about the *optional* Labors of Hercules events. If you wish to do one of these events, check the appropriate event on the fee section, include the cost in your registration, and fill out a Waiver of Liability and Release. If you opt not to do any of the Labors of Hercules, you do not need to fill out the Waiver of Liability and Release.
- Make checks payable to **Cascadia JCL**, unless your sponsor directs you to do otherwise.
- Cancellations received at least a week before the convention date will receive a partial refund of \$120. Substitutions of the same gender may be made at any time without penalty (exception – Labors of Hercules tickets are non-refundable and non-transferrable; see p. 3 of the registration form).

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The registration packet consists of seven pages, but you will only fill out three of them (four if you are doing the Labors of Hercules):

- 1) **ALL convention attendees, including sponsors and chaperones, must fill out the convention registration form on pages 1 and 2.**
- 2) **Any convention attendees who wish to do one of the *optional* Labors of Hercules should read page 3, add the appropriate fee to the fee section on page 1, and fill out the Warm Beach Waiver of Liability and Release.** Attendees *not* doing the Labors of Hercules do not need to fill out the Warm Beach Waiver of Liability and Release.
- 3) **All students must fill out the Convention Contest Registration Form on page 4.**
Registering for an event does not obligate you to participate in it, but it will aid the convention organizers in their planning. For contest rules and descriptions, please visit the website at www.wabcjcl.org.
- 4) **All chaperones who have *not* studied classics should please fill out the Chaperone Form on page 5.**
The convention organizers and volunteers are grateful to chaperones for your help in supervising the weekend's events. Your assistance ensures that delegates receive adequate supervision and that events run smoothly and safely. Thank you for your help!
- 5) **All sponsors/teachers and any chaperones who have studied classics should please fill out the Judging Registration Form on page 6.**
If everyone who knows Latin or has studied the classics will help out by judging a couple of contests (each lasting about an hour), all events can be judged fairly and the burden on each judge will be fairly light. If you have never judged at a JCL convention before, the event chair will provide you with orientation and instructions. On behalf of our contest participants, thank you for your help!

Convention Costs

The convention cost of \$180 for delegates and \$155 for adults covers lodging for Friday and Saturday night and meals from Friday dinner through Sunday lunch. Lodging is on site in cabins at Warm Beach Camp and Conference Center. The convention cost also includes a convention T-shirt and free access to all convention events except the ‘Labors of Hercules,’ which are available for an additional fee (see p. 3).

Linen Fee (optional)

Delegations may either bring their own bedding and towels or they may rent a linen packet for the weekend at an additional cost of \$12 per person. Rental of linen packets should be done by delegation; that is, either all members of your delegation rent linen packets, or you should all bring your own bedding and towels. Ask your sponsor whether your delegation is renting linen packets or not. If so, please add the \$12 linen fee to your registration.

Media Release

Attendees of the Cascadia Junior Classical League convention may have their likeness reproduced in photos, video recordings, and other media for the non-commercial purposes of publicity and promotion of the Cascadia Junior Classical League and its activities. **The attendee’s name will not be included in any media without the attendee’s consent** (or the consent of a parent/guardian for minors).

Signatures

Attendees agree to obey all Conference Center and JCL rules or risk expulsion from the convention at their own inconvenience and cost. **The behavior of delegates and chaperones is the primary responsibility of their sponsor or teacher.** Any damage caused by delegates will be the responsibility of the delegate and the parent/guardian of the delegate. 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'LABORS OF HERCULES' REGISTRATION – OPTIONAL FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

The Labors of Hercules is optional for all attendees.

All attendees may participate in one of the following 'Labors of Hercules' activities, subject to available space and for an additional cost, which must be paid with your convention registration. These activities are offered by our host, Warm Beach Camp & Conference Center, and are conducted by their staff.

Participation is completely voluntary. If you do not want to do one of these activities, you do not have to sign up for one. All 'Labors of Hercules' run on Saturday afternoon starting at 1 o'clock. Climbing tower sessions are 60 minutes each and high ropes sessions are 90 minutes each.

N.B.! Every effort is made to avoid conflicts with the convention activities that you mark on the contest registration page (p. 4). Hence, it is critical that you complete the convention registration page accurately. Please be aware that despite the best efforts of the convention organizers, some conflicts may be unavoidable.

High Ropes Course (\$14 per person, minimum age 12 years old): The High Ropes Challenge Course exceeds ACCT safety standards and consists of different wood, rope, and cable elements 25 feet above the ground. Facilitators help users to get out of their comfort zone into a situation of 'perceived risk' where growth occurs from facing fears and challenges.

Climbing Tower (\$10 per person, minimum age 7 years old): The Climbing Tower is a three-sided, 40-foot tower with varying degrees of climbing challenge. Facilitators help climbers on the tower in a way that teaches safety, new skills, and new outlook.

How to register:

- (1) Mark the event of your choice in the fee section of page 1. Choose only one event.
- (2) Include the cost of the event with your registration. Forms received without full payment will not be registered for the Labors of Hercules.
- (3) Read and sign the Warm Beach **Waiver of Liability and Release** (included in your registration packet). Youth delegates, have a parent or guardian read and sign this form, too. For group name, write **Cascadia JCL plus the name of your school**. Return the Waiver of Liability and Release with your registration.
- (4) Your registration must arrive by the postmarked deadline of February 8, 2020. Late registrations will not be eligible for the Labors of Hercules.
- (5) If more requests are received than there is space available, participation in the Labors of Hercules will be determined by lottery, with youth delegates being given priority over adults. If you are not selected for the event of your choice, you will receive a full refund of the cost of the event.
- (6) If you are selected for an event, you will receive a ticket at the convention with your name and the time of your event.
- (7) Once your registration has been processed, the fee for the Labors of Hercules is non-refundable. Tickets for the Labors of Hercules are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Injuries can include, but are not limited to; cable burns, rope burns, sprains, skin abrasions, and pulled/strained muscles. In the unlikely event of a failure of a helmet, belay, or other safety precautions, more serious injuries or even death could result.

Release of Liability

I, the undersigned, understand that parts of the Challenge Course experience at Warm Beach Camp may be physically or emotionally demanding. In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Challenge Course at Warm Beach Camp, I, the undersigned, in full recognition and appreciation of the dangers and risks inherent in such activities, do hereby waive, release, and forever discharge *Warm Beach Christian Camp and Conference Center*, its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, action or causes of action for costs, expenses or damages to personal property or personal injury, or death, which may result from my participation in these activities.
